Krewson Terrace

Speed Study August 2015

Initial Complaint:

A resident reported that vehicles speed at all times of the day on the one hundred block of Krewson Terrace.

Description of Area:

The one hundred block of Krewson Terrace is located in the south east corner of Upper Moreland Township. It is a local roadway in a residential neighborhood where homes line both sides of the roadway and the roadway is wide enough to accommodate on street parking on the south side of the street. The one hundred block of Krewson Terrace runs between Church Street and Nash Avenue. The speed limit is 25 mph.

Data Gathering Method:

Speed/volume counters were placed in front of 113 Krewson Terrace for a period of seven days.

Hazardous Factors:

The speed of vehicles using this section of Krewson Terrace indicated that 0.06% of vehicles met the threshold for enforcement. The 85th percentile speed for vehicles on this section of Krewson Terrace is 21.71 mph.

During the study period, 3,004 vehicles traveled on this section of Krewson Terrace.

Analysis:

At this time, speeding is not an issue on the one hundred block of Krewson Terrace. The average speed is 16.28 mph.

Response:

This location does not require enhanced patrol at this time.
