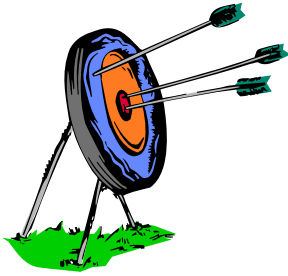


ARCHERY RANGE PERMIT APPLICATION



PERMIT REGULATIONS:

-All persons must have a valid U.M. Twp. “Archery Range Permit” when using the Archery Range at Masons Mill Park. The permit year runs from July 1-June 30. **ALL PERMITS EXPIRE ON JUNE 30**, regardless of their purchase date. Archers must “check-in” & “check-out” at the Park Office (when staffed) before and after use of the range. Archers using the range without a permit or without checking-in/out are subject to citation and/or permit revocation.

-Permits are issued only at the Parks and Recreation Office in the Township Building, 117 Park Avenue, Willow Grove, 215.659-3100 ext. 1039, M-F, 8:30A-4:30P. If claimed, proof of U.M. Township residency is required at time of purchase.

-Permits are only issued to **INDIVIDUALS**, rather than groups. Due to liability concerns, **ALL** individuals and family members using the range must have a valid Archery Range Permit (there are no “guest” privileges on the range).

Archery Range Permit FEES: (Permit Year – July 1 thru June 30)

UM Twp. Residents:

Note: less 50% if permit is purchased between Jan. 1 & June 1.

\$15.00 for **Twp. Resident Youngsters** (age 17 & under)

\$35.00 for **Twp. Resident Adults** (ages 18+)

\$50.00 Family Fee: Permits will be issued to each individual; maximum of 2 Adults, and all youngsters must be age 17 and under, a member of the immediate family & residing in the same U.M. Twp. Household. Individual rates apply to all others.

Non-Residents:

Note: less 50% if permit is purchased between Jan. 1 & June 1.

\$30.00 for **Non-Resident Youngsters** (age 17 & under)

\$50.00 for **Non-Resident Adults** (age 18+)

\$75.00 Family Fee: Permits will be issued to each individual; maximum of 2 Adults, and all youth must be age 17 and under, a member of the immediate family & residing in the same household. Individual rates apply to all others.

ALL ARCHERY RANGE PERMITS expire on JUNE 30. Permits for the new year (July 1-June 30) will be sold beginning June 1 and will be valid for immediate use.

ALL YOUTH PERMIT HOLDERS (age 17 & under) must be accompanied by an adult whenever using the range. The supervising adult must be at the range to help assure safe practices. As long as the adult does not shoot, no permit is required.

TARGET RANGE RULES

- All persons using the TARGET RANGE must have a valid Archery Range Permit, issued by Upper Moreland Township, Parks and Recreation Office.
- All archers must sign-in & sign-out at the Park Office, if staffed. If the office is not staffed, all archers must have their permit on-hand ready to be displayed should a staff member inquire.
- Only TARGET ARROWS with FIELD POINTS may be used on the range.
ALL TYPES OF BROADHEADS AND CROSSBOWS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
Violators are subject to revocation of permit & citation.
- Shoot only at bales provided. Archers must supply targets, and remove them after use. Please place all litter in the trash receptacles provided.
- No more than [2] shooters are permitted at each station.
- Shoot only at the target directly in front of your shooting position.
- Shooters must stay behind the shooting line until all archers have completed shooting that round.
- STOP shooting immediately if any dangerous situation develops, and call on other shooters to do the same. Shooting MUST STOP if any person(s), train, or vehicle crosses behind the range or on the railroad upgrade.
- You may take up to [5] minutes to search for lost arrows; after all fellow shooters have suspended action.
- The first adult archer on the range will act as the RANGE OFFICER. All archers arriving later will shoot as directed by the RANGE OFFICER. The RANGE OFFICER will also assure that no one is down range when shooting commences. When the RANGE OFFICER leaves, the person who arrived next becomes the RANGE OFFICER.
- All spectators must be outside the range fencing and behind the shooting line.

Safe and accident-free use of the range is your responsibility. The archer assumes all responsibility for all accidents, injuries, and property damage. Archery Shooting is a dangerous activity that may result in serious injury or even death.

BY PURCHASE OF THIS PERMIT, YOU AGREE TO HOLD-HARMLESS THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER MORELAND AND ALL STAFF MEMBERS FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGES.
